***Each Tour will leave PROMPTLY 15 minutes before the tour time, to allow time to walk there.***

*New this year, there will be chance to take tours even if you didn't sign up.... If there are extra spots that come available, they will be given out on a first-come-first-served basis. If your student wants to take a tour they did not sign up for, have them come to the tour area, then if a spot becomes available, they will be given out in the order that they showed up. It's like flying "standby", if there's room, they will be allowed to go, but there is NO guarantee they will get to go on the tour. So, for this reason, please be sure your students that ARE signed up, show up at LEAST 15-20 minutes before, because if they are late, and we give their spot to someone else, if they show up late, even though they have a ticket, they will not be allowed to go.*

*There are NEW tours this year, so I thought I would give you a little information about what they are.*

***Lincoln Journal Star:*** You will see the press building, the paper room and where it comes from, and the inserting machines. They will talk about the jobs available and all the positions it takes to successfully get the paper out each day. They will also talk about changes in the industry—such as the benefits and repercussions of the “online” news.

***Governors' Mansion:*** This tour is shorter than usual; it's only a ½ hour tour instead of an hour. You will see the Governors' Mansion, the formal dining room, the sitting room. It's really a nice tour!!

***City County Building:*** They will talk to you about the duties of the Mayors' Office, a police officer will talk to you about their duties, you will see the 911 operators at work and they will talk to you about 911 calls. Then you will go into a court room and a Judge will talk to you about the 'court' process. If there is time, and if court is in session, you will get to go into a court room and watch a little bit of court. *~~Please note that if you go on this tour, you are subject to be searched and will have to go through a metal detector.*

***Children's Museum:*** They will talk about child development, how exhibits are chosen, and there will be a few minutes to explore the Museum.

***State Capital:*** This is tour of the State Capital. If this time doesn't fit into your schedule, remember that your chapter can tour the capital without this scheduled tour. They give tours every hour on the hour there. So your chapter can go at your convenience if this tour doesn't work for you.
