Nebraska Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc. Chapter Award Application Guidelines

Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) members are to set realistic goals for themselves and to conduct a balanced chapter program of work that is related to the family and consumer sciences program. The goals should help young men and women become leaders and address personal, family, work, and societal issues through family and consumer science education focusing on the multiple roles of family member, wage earner, and community leaders. Members will develop skills for life in character development, creative and critical thinking, interpersonal communication, practical knowledge, and career preparation.

DEADLINES:

November 1: Chapter Affiliation sent to Nationals

February 1: Application due in the State Department (postmark deadline will not be considered)

OFFICIAL RULES:

- Projects must be carried out between February 1 of the previous year to January 31 of the current year.
- Chapter may submit only one Chapter Award. If a school has a junior and a senior chapter, they may each submit an award.
- The chapter award must reflect the work of FCCLA members.
- Attachments must be typed, font type Times New Roman with a minimum of 10-point size.
- For award consideration, applications must be in to the Nebraska State FCCLA Adviser before February 1, so they are in the office before the February Meeting.
- Projects will be disqualified for award or level of award for failing to submit the required information in all categories.

AWARD: Members of the State Advisory Committee, the State Officer Team will check for completion and verify the award applied for.

Chapters must complete all projects in the BRONZE Row for a BRONZE AWARD, They must complete ALL BRONZE AND SILVER FOR A SILVER AWARD, AND THEY MUST COMPLETE ALL BOXES FOR A GOLD AWARD.
