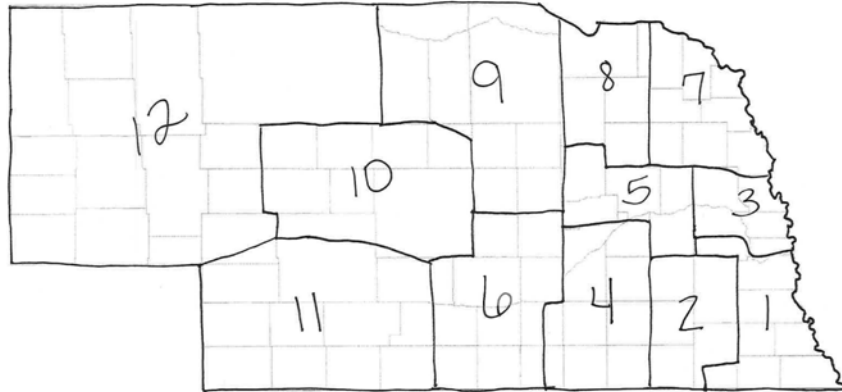

## **FCCLA DUES**

Nebraska FCCLA dues are \$13.00 per member, which breaks down to, \$9.00--National dues and \$4.00--State dues. Our State participates in the Direct Affiliation program with National Headquarters. This means that your chapter affiliates **both State and National dues directly with National Headquarters Office.**

**National Dues Support:** publications and *TEEN TIMES*; regional Cluster Meetings; National Executive Council meetings; National Meeting; salaries for national staff members; travel expenses for professional staff members to work in states; stationery, envelopes, postage and other office supplies.

**State Dues Support:** expenses of State PEER Teams, Board of Directors, District Advisers, and State Officer Team, FCCLA state projects, supplies, and publications. \$1.00 from dues is used to support scholarships & STAR.

## **STATE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE QUOTA (SLC)**

All chapters will be able to bring to SLC a base quota of youth delegates derived from current chapter membership as follows:

1-20 members.....	6 youth delegates
21-40 members.....	7 youth delegates
41-60 members.....	8 youth delegates
61 or more members.....	9 youth delegates

Chapters will also be able to bring additional delegates above this quota if they fit these categories:

- Current State Officers, Current PEER State Officers, State Officer Candidates & State Peer Officer Candidates, Current District President (only if conducting a District Meeting at SLC), State STAR participants, Foreign exchange students who are current FCCLA members, All delegates must pay full conference fee

1. DO NOT send a copy of a newspaper article from a local newspaper. Write the article yourself.
2. Include the name and phone number of the chapter adviser in the upper right-hand corner.
3. Remember the Who, What, When, Where, Why, and How.
4. A good headline will grab a reader's eye. Write the release, with a headline, introductory sentence and quotes.
5. Use the closing paragraph to provide information about FCCLA.
6. PROOFREAD! Double-check names, dates, places, numbers, quotes, spelling, and grammar.
7. If possible, include an action-shot photo of FCCLA members taking part in the event.
