

GUIDELINES TO RESPECTING OTHER GUESTS

It is our goal that all our guests have a safe and restful stay with us. It is with that goal in mind that it is necessary to state “house rules” that apply to youth groups that have attendees that are under the age of 18 staying in the hotel.

- 1) The guestroom hallways on floors 3-10, elevators and stairways are for the purposes of transporting all guests to their rooms. These are not areas to gather and socialize. Horseplay, loud talking, singing, slamming doors is not allowed at any time.
- 2) **At 10:00 pm the Hotel will be enforcing “quiet hours”.** In-room gatherings are not allowed, and attendees should only be in the room to which they are registered. It is understood that there are events planned until 11:45 pm. Students should only be traveling between their rooms and the elevators, and not gathering in the hallways.
- 3) For your personal safety, and to keep noise to a minimum, **do not prop your door open at any time.** Your intention might be to let a friend in, but there are extreme dangers to exposing yourself to strangers by propping doors open. **Do not post your room number or phone number in the window of your room!** This is a very dangerous activity, as the windows can be seen by the general public.
- 4) Each student has a designated Advisor. **Anyone that breaks “house rules” will be reported to their Advisor immediately.** A second call will result in a parent/guardian called to pick you up. Dangerous or disrupting behavior not listed in this document will result in the same consequences.
- 5) Any damage (including food and beverage spills) that occurs in your guestroom must be reported immediately. Failure to do so, and the hotel subsequently **discovering damage upon your check-out, will result in those damages being assessed to your bill** (or the master account for your group).
- 6) **Do not attempt to hook up any game systems, DVD players or VCR’s to the in-room televisions.** All external jacks have been disabled on the TV’s. Any attempt to disconnect the cable from the television will break an internal component rendering the television useless. If this happens there will be a **\$500.00 repair fee** attached to the room bill. **This is not negotiable!**
- 7) Fines and damages will be assessed to any individual that tampers with fire safety equipment.
