How can you get involved?



## **1. What does the Service Project entail?**

Nebraska FCCLA members have amazing service projects each and every year. This year we wanted to give you an opportunity to get the recognition that you deserve. We believe that it is important to contribute to the national service project because we have such great organizations that we are working with. It gives chapters the opportunity to work with not one but three organizations with very different, meaningful causes. I understand that there are many questions that have arisen about the service project regarding where you send money, and what forms there are to fill out. So here are some FAQ and answers.

## **2. Where do we send our money and/or shoes to?**

In order to receive national recognition you must send everything to nationals. The website that you can do this through is [fclclainc.org](http://fclclainc.org) but more specifically, <http://fclclainc.org/content/level-iii-soles4souls/> for soles4souls, or [http://www.strength.org/get\\_involved/fccla\\_and\\_no\\_kid\\_hungry/](http://www.strength.org/get_involved/fccla_and_no_kid_hungry/) for Share our Strength. These websites should make everything much more clear. March of Dimes is more of an awareness project, it is not really designed to make money. This was something new from nationals this year to give chapters a break from constantly raising funds. Visit the March of Dimes section on the national website for more information on this.

## **3. How do we contact Nebraska FCCLA about our service projects?**

We want to know about what you have done! That way you get the state recognition as well. To make this process easier we have created a form to fill out and send to the state officer.

## **4. Is the form the only thing that we need to send in?**

No, we would love for you to send pictures of your projects to us display at the State Leadership Conference.

## **5. Do we have to send everything to Nationals?**

No! This is where we wanted to leave it in your hands. If there is a family group that you would like to help in your community then we would love for you to be able to do that. However, you would only be able to receive state recognition if you chose this. There is no right or wrong answer for us to set in to place, we only wanted to make you aware of this.

## **6. When is everything due to the state office?**

In order to have everything in order for state we need to have all of your information to Rachel Kermmoade by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. Your projects may include anything that you did after the 2010 school year, and during the 2011-2012 year.
