### FCCLA SLC T-shirt Contest Rules

---

1. Your name and chapter need to be clearly printed on design. Not as a part of the design, but so your name and chapter will be printed with the design.
2. Colors are limited to 3 colors of your choice. However, the FCCLA logo must be in the design and can only be red, white or black.
3. Include the theme "Creating the Leaders of Tomorrow-Today"
4. Design entries cannot use established trademarks, trademarked designs or phrases such as "FCCLA – home is where the heart is." If there are any questions regarding the originality of an idea, phrase or concept look into copyright law and check out the idea or phrase at <http://www.uspto.gov/>, the United States Patent and Trademark Office.
5. FCCLA will not accept any designs that feature:
  - o Existing registered trademarks or trademark slogans. (such as 'Don't Leave Home Without It', Pillsbury, Martha Stewart, etc.)
  - o Tobacco, firearms, alcohol, profanity, and/or sexual connotations.
  - o Distortions of the FCCLA emblem.
6. Do not use Internet design companies to create and submit your entry. Online design companies make their money selling tees, once you have created the design on their site the copyright belongs to them, which would prohibit FCCLA from reproducing the tee should that design be selected as a winner. The artwork must be your own.
7. Designs and/or design concepts must be created by FCCLA chapters and/or FCCLA members. Do not use professional design firms.
8. The Nebraska FCCLA State Officers will select the winning entry.
9. All entries become the property of FCCLA.
10. The winning design will be released on the website on or before March 1, 2012.

Entries must be electronically submitted to the State Office on or before January 27, 2012. Please note that sometimes the Government computers do not deliver mail from yahoo, hotmail or gmail accounts. For that reason, once you have submitted your entry, give the State Office a couple of days and then check the [www.nebraskafccla.org](http://www.nebraskafccla.org) website to be sure your entry was received. If you don't see your name/chapter on that list, use a different email provider and submit again.
