

**NEBRASKA ASSOCIATION OF FCCLA
FCCLA SCHOLARSHIP AWARD POLICIES
FOR: FACS Collegiate Scholarship**

I. Guidelines/Regulations

1. The Nebraska Association of FCCLA offers two \$200 tuition scholarships to former members to continue college work beyond the sophomore year of college.
2. The recipient may not be a current recipient of the Nebraska Association of FCCLA Family and Consumer Sciences Education Major scholarship.
3. The recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university in Nebraska with a declared major leading to a degree in Family and Consumer Sciences Education. A minimum course load of 12 credit hours per semester must be carried to maintain eligibility.
4. The recipient must have completed at least two years of college by the time the scholarship is to be used and be of sophomore or junior standing to apply.
5. The recipient must reapply on a yearly basis but is eligible to receive this scholarship for a maximum of two years.
6. Upon written verification of the recipient's enrollment in a college or university, the scholarship award shall be disbursed to the college/university Registrar or Financial Officer in the amount of \$100 per semester for a total of \$200 annually. The scholarship must be used in the next semester after it is presented. Should the applicant change majors, the scholarship will become void. The scholarship winner must notify, in writing, the State Adviser with their intent to accept the scholarship by May 1.
7. Representatives of the District Advisory Committee and State Officer Team shall serve as the Scholarship Committee and shall name the recipient(s) and alternate(s) for this scholarship
8. The recipient(s) shall be announced before the annual FCCLA State Leadership Conference. The recipients do not have to be present to accept the award.

II. Qualifications

1. The applicant must be a former member of a FCCLA chapter.
2. The applicant must have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA in college course work.
3. The applicant will be required to include the following supporting materials **with** their application:
 - a) Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from your college adviser or a faculty member from your college.
 - b) Complete college transcript including the immediately preceding semester.

This application, letters of recommendation (one from local chapter member/officer, 1 from FACS teacher/FCCLA Adviser, and one from school administrator) and high school transcripts must be collected and emailed by the applicant's adviser by **February 1** to the current **Nebraska FCCLA Board of Directors Chair**. This information can be found in the *Red Handbook*. Applications sent to the State Adviser will not be accepted.
