


Clarification on Rules for 2021 Nebraska State STAR Events Allowable Presentation Equipment

For events that allow presentation equipment, 2021 Nebraska STAR Event Virtual Competition participants will be allowed to project their digital visuals onto a classroom screen during their presentation.


This could include a traditional projection screen, a SmartBoard or an electronic device such as a monitor or television screen.

Evaluators at the *STATE LEVEL* will be instructed **NOT** to deduct points based on how a student presents their project - either from a computer screen or a projected screen.

National Programs in Action



National Programs in Action, an individual or team event, recognizes participants who explain how the Planning Process was used to plan and implement a national program project. Participants must prepare a file folder, an oral presentation, and visuals.

ELIGIBILITY & GENERAL INFORMATION

- Review "Eligibility and General Rules for All Levels of Competition" on page 73 prior to event planning and preparation.
- Choose one of the FCCLA national programs from page 79.
- Participants are encouraged to bring fully charged devices such as laptops, tablets, etc., to use for audiovisual presentation at in-person competitions.
- Chapters with multiple entries in this event must submit different projects for each entry. All projects must be developed and completed during a one-year span beginning July 1 and ending June 30 of the school year before the National Leadership Conference, and must be the work of the participant[s] only.
- National Leadership Conference (in-person competition) participants will view the online orientation video found on the official FCCLA YouTube channel, available in early June. Each entry must complete and submit the required form to the event room consultant at the time of competition. Only one form per entry is required. Contact State Advisers for orientation procedures for competitions held prior to National Leadership Conference. If events are held virtually, these points will be automatically awarded to all participants.

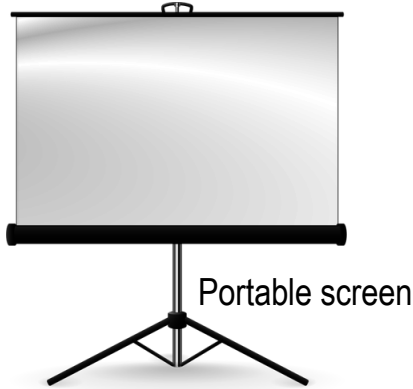

Clarification on Rules for National STAR Events Allowable Presentation Equipment

***Anything that is portable, does not require an electrical outlet, and fits within the competition space.

- Laptop computers, iPads, Chromebooks, etc. that are fully charged are permissible.
- Portable screens, projectors, etc. that run off of a battery.




Battery powered- portable projector

*****Not allowed (even for virtual presentations)** - anything that requires wall space, hangs on a wall or must be plugged in to an electrical outlet at the time of presentation.
Example: a classroom smart board.


*****Always double check the allowable elements in the Competitive Events Guide for your specific event. Some events do not allow presentation equipment of any kind.**

Essentially, for nationals (virtual or in-person) the only allowable presentation devices are those that run off of a battery and can fit within the compact contest space.
