



## Honorary Conference Assistant 2022 State Leadership Conference

Honorary Conference Assistants play a vital role in the operation and success of our annual State Leadership Conference. The following requirements must be met for members to apply to be Honorary Conference Assistants:

- Currently a Junior or Senior in High School
- Strong FCCLA Experience and Knowledge in the FCCLA organization
- Previously attended an in-person SLC
- **Members who are participating in STAR Events are not eligible!**

Conference Assistants have the following responsibilities throughout the conference:

- Ensure correct AV and room set-up
- Usher for sessions
- Assist with STAR as needed
- Assist with STAR line-up during Recognition
- Assist attendees in finding rooms
- Assist at the Opportunity Fair as needed
- Ensure individuals with assigned seating find their seats prior to sessions.
- Ensure proper dress and tickets at dance and **will** attend the dance

**Failure to fulfill complete required tasks will result in the Honorary Conference Assistant Coordinator contacting the advisor and possible removal from the Conference Assistant Team.**

Conference Assistants will receive their specific assignments at their **mandatory Orientation Session from 4:00 PM-5:00 PM on Sunday, April 4**. In exchange for their time, their conference registration will be reduced by 50%, they will receive a free conference t-shirt, and will be provided with lunch on Monday.

Complete applications are due by **Thursday, February 10, 2022 at 5:00pm CDT** and those who are chosen will be notified by **Tuesday, February 15**. Five individuals will be selected as Honorary Conference Assistants this year.
