One should be completed by the candidate's chapter adviser and the other by an adult who is familiar with the candidate's non-FCCLA activities. When the chapter adviser is the parent of the applicant, the letter should be written by another adult school staff member.
- Submit the completed application and Letters of Recommendation by January 15 to the State Adviser at stateadviser@nebraskafccla.org.
- Attend the State Officer Candidate Screening Day, February 7, 2024 in Lincoln, for the interview and knowledge test portion of the process.
- Present a speech at State Leadership Conference. The speech may be up to three minutes in length and
 must be presented without visuals. The speech will presented on the national topic, which will be
 available in Spring 2024 and can be found on the National FCCLA website: fcclainc.org/lead/national-officer-election-information
